Call to order March 14, 2016, at noon by Chairman Don Zeller

- Members record volunteer hours
- Motion by John, second by David to approve minutes of January 11 and February 8 meetings; motion carried. Motion by John and second by David to approve Treasurer's report; motion carried
- No Building permit review

Old Business

- Fort Pierre Historical sign update, two refurbished signs near RR Depot, new sign for RR Depot, new sign for Stockgrowers bank ready for installation.
- Sansarc school sign is on order.
- Second Turtle Effigy (on highway 1804) signs to direct foot traffic, ordered; both signs will be installed at same time
- Grant options – decision to refurbish old historical markers, signs: 100 meridian west of Blunt; sign at Medicine Creek on Hwy 34; repair base on Ft Pierre Pull-out markers by RR Depot. SDDOT is removing and replacing signs.
- Ft Pierre 200th birthday celebration Sept. 22-24, 2017; Ted Spencer outlined what requests Don provided from the meeting that could be covered by our grant including signs if historic; driving tour pamphlet; Book for Bicentennial if not for profit; Bus Tour handout; match with people working on the project at \$19.65/hour; no flags or banners
- New grant application deadline is March 31, 2016.
- Ft. Pierre Chouteau plan: outlined by Betsey with rendering and power point showing tower area destination and needs for signage and parking at the site. Loren at Brosz rough estimate of building cost to be \$14,000 – \$16,000 or half that with donated labor. The plaque on west side of monument needs to be replaced. Dave Bonde will visit and determine how plaque is mounted on monument. Ted recommended meeting with SHPO staff and Jay Vogt with a package of details of the plan. Betsey will meet with Archeologist Paige Olson first on Tuesday. Betsey will check out the bike trail windscreen bench source with Tom Farnsworth. Site includes 36 acres.
- Google Field Trip app for “location aware” to find historic homes on our web site.

New Business

- Working on additions to Historic Places web site: civil war memorial (triangle lot) Kathy; first school Betsey, legion cabin we will ask Chris Nelson; hospital and governor's mansion not assigned yet.
- SD State Historical Society conference April 29 – 30, 2016 Ramkota Pierre. Theme is “Everybody Eats – SD Food Heritage”. Motion by John to approve four members registration, second by Kathy. Motion carried. Members attending will be Don, Betsey, Kathy, and one other. Members pay for their registration and will be reimbursed with appropriate receipt. Betsey will have a retail booth and will display country school lunch items, and include HPC brochures for attendees.
- Develop a driving tour of Pierre and Ft Pierre: Don, Deb, Betsey, Kathy will help with layout.
