Tony Jockheck from Northridge Plaza requested to hold a carnival on August 24th thru 27th in the mall parking lot. Tony confirmed that security has been hired and that the proceeds will go to the Capital Area United Way. Commissioner Huizenga moved and Commissioner Harding seconded to approve the carnival at Northridge Plaza on August 24th-27th. Unanimous approval.

Sarah Brusseau provided an overview of the Pre-Mustang Rally to be held in the parking lot of Pub 34 on August 27th from 5pm-10pm. The Pub will be providing food and alcohol in the parking lot, which is part of their licensed premise and covered by their exiting license.

Tom Farnsworth, Park & Recreation Director, presented a resolution to support the application for a Land and Water Conservation Funding Grant for the 2017 fiscal year. The project would be for a concession and bathroom building to be constructed on the Dan Kelley baseball field. The grant requires

50% match by the City, which Tom indicated would be raised from local grants or organization donations. Commissioner Harding moved and Commissioner Mehlhaff seconded to approve Resolution 2592. Unanimous approval.

Twila Hight, Finance Officer, presented a request to transfer \$1,800 from the General Fund to the Police Pistol Range Fund. The 2015 revenues were inadvertently deposited into the General Fund, so these funds need to be moved. Commissioner Huizenga moved and commissioner Barringer seconded to approve the cash transfer of \$1,800 from General Fund to Police Pistol Range Fund as presented. Unanimous approval.

Commissioner Huizenga moved and Commissioner Harding seconded to adjourn. 7:27pm Unanimous approval.
