#### Old Business

  - Two Central SD map signs clean up – done.
  - History unfolds historical marker – total refurbish started.
- Fort Pierre Chouteau Tower project – specifications and grants:
  - PFPHPC can apply for \$10,000 Deadwood Grant as suggested by Ted Spencer who will process this new plan through the Board of Trustees meeting on April 27. Don Zeller will write grant.
  - Loren at Brosz will respond with updated rendering and materials list for quotes in a couple of days; Rick Hahn with the City of Fort Pierre will handle the bidding process.
  - The City of Fort Pierre has agreed to provide the funding necessary to support the bidding, and will be paid back with donations and grant monies received. Roxanne and Twila will coordinate this.
  - Deb will write grant to the Community Fund.
  - Kathy submitted a grant request to the DAR.
  - Deb received a commitment for \$6000 to date, letters of request will be sent out later, depending on the current verbal personal approach for donations.
